Wild Pig wines are mainly made from grapes grown in the Languedoc region of southern France. The Languedoc stretches from the banks of the Rhône River in the east to the city of Carcassonne in the west, and from the first foothills of the Massif Central Mountains in the north to the Mediterranean coast in the south. The Languedoc is the oldest wine producing region in France. It benefits from a hot climate, ideal for growing grapes and making wines that are fruity in character with intense aromas.



January and February were relatively warm months with decent rainfall. During the Spring several heavy rainfalls proved very beneficial in restocking the water table and thus providing valuable water resource for the early growth stages of the vines. Summer, with its very warm temperatures, particularly in July, provided the heat necessary for an even and wholesome ripeness. **2015 shows an important aromatic potential!**

Wines are generous and boast great balance. The white are fresh and very aromatic, particularly the Viognier which offers intense aromas of apricot jam! While the rosé wines show appetizing notes of grenadine, the red wines are rich with silky and velvety tannins. 2015 vintage is already showing great potential and is most definitely one of the best vintages of the last few years for our winery.
